5th international typography project ArchiTypo 2024

## Statute

Our project popularizes values related to traditional printing and typography. It allows you to recreate the disappearing craft of typesetting and hand printing techniques. As part of the project, we encourage artists to create posters using traditional printing techniques using wooden and metal movable fonts. Previous editions have shown that the black art - typesetting and hand printing - is enough to convey timeless thoughts, ideas, words and signs.

The first two editions were devoted to the work of Stanisław Lem (LemPress), the next ones were related to the 550th anniversary of the birth of Nicolaus Copernicus (CopernicusPress). This year we are inviting letterpress studios to create posters related to architecture. Much is said about the architecture of the letter and its structure. Will it be possible to create and recreate places, urban space of cities, buildings using typography?

The project will ended exhibitions, among others: in the "Stary Ratusz" Gallery of the WBP in Olsztyn and in the Wozownia Sztuk in Frombork. Once the project is completed, the exhibition will be available for loan.
