Statute

International typographic project PoeTry 2025 – taste Poe. (Edgar Allan Poe). We invite printing studios to create works related to the works of Edgar Allan Poe. 2025 marks the 180th anniversary of the first publication of the poem "The Raven". The raven is a bird that has in culture many meanings. "White Raven" is a term to the of rare, valuable prints, bibliophilic copies. "The Order of the White Raven with sunflower" is for merits in bibliophilic activities.

Our typographic project is intended to create unique prints. Edgar Allan Poe's achievements include not only poems, but also the first crime novel. His works are characterized by a specific mood, irony and grotesque. This will be our sixth meeting - the sixth edition of the international typography project. The previous ones were held under the slogan of LemPress, CopernicusPress and ArchiTypo. As part of the project, artists create works prepared using traditional printing techniques using wooden and metal movable fonts and matrices. Previous editions have shown that the black art of typesetting hand printing is enough to convey timeless thoughts, ideas, words and signs. The project aims to draw attention to the values associated with traditional printing, present the history and promote the disappearing craft of typesetting and hand printing techniques.
